

English Language Paper 2

- 1) Read questions 1, 2 and 3. Make sure you know what you're looking for (for Q3, which source is being referred to?).
Read Source A. Underline/highlight/annotate quotes that will help you answer these questions. (5 minutes)
- 2) Carefully choose the correct statements for Q1 (5 minutes)
- 3) Reread question 2. Make sure you know what you're looking for. Identify 3-4 key similarities/differences (depending on what the question is asking) (5 minutes)
- 4) Answer Q2. Use PEE and compare as you go (high marks go for perceptive and detailed interpretations). (10 minutes)
- 5) Reread the named source for Q3 and check you can analyse 3-4 language features in detail. Use plenty of quotes, subject terminology, and always talk about the effect on the reader (PEEL) (15 minutes).
- 6) Identify 3-4 points you can compare in the writers' attitudes. In each paragraph, identify the attitude of a writer, give a quote to support and explain what this shows, then compare to an attitude from the other writer (20 minutes).
- 7) Choose which question you will answer for Q5. Jot down a brief plan. Make sure your writing uses a wide variety of accurate paragraphs, sentence forms, punctuation and vocabulary/spelling (40 minutes).
