We also aim to develop the skills pupils need to be successful at writing applications and excelling in the interview process.

Our careers programme begins in Year 7 where we look at helping pupils develop their own areas of interest by exposing them to many different subject areas and employer experiences alongside our personal development days.

Mrs Sue Tunstall from Purple Patch Careers is our school careers adviser and works in school every Tuesday. All pupils receive at least one careers interview in their time at the school, this usually takes places at some stage in Years 9-11.

Log on, Move on

All Year 10 pupils will shortly be receiving a username and password to access their learner account on Log On Move On. They will receive this via their school email address from eprospectus. We hope to also set up accounts for the current Year 8 and 9 prior to the summer break. However all pupils can access the general resources on the website at the above address.

Log On Move On is a careers gateway that covers all of Hull, the East Riding and North Yorkshire Coast. It is a single source of information and resources to support careers education and progression for the local area and includes an on-line prospectus of local education and training opportunities after Year 11. Your child will be able to retain and use this account until Year 14, adding to it as they progress regardless of which post 16 options they choose.

Parents of Year 10 pupils: Please support your child by ensuring they access both their learner account and the home learning career resources.

In their learner account:

1. Complete their personal details
2. Look for and complete the intended destination section
3. Complete a Curriculum Vitae using the CV writer to assist
4. Start the East Riding Employability Passport; there is a step-by-step guide to help

On the main website pages:

5. Complete virtual work experience using Barclays Life Skills
6. Learn about Labour Market Information, so they know what jobs are available and in which employment sectors, and future employment opportunities
7. Learn about local education, training and apprenticeship opportunities
8. Develop their general careers knowledge
