Examination Results: Thursday 20 August 2020

Due to the expected continuation of COVID-19 restrictions we will have a slightly different arrangement this year for collecting exam results. Results will be available for collection from school on the morning of Thursday 20 August from 10.00 am in Tutor Groups as follows;

10.00 am 11LSV

10.15 am 11KWT

10.30 am 11PS

10.45 am 11EC

If the weather is good we will do this outside on the playground where students will be able to discuss results with staff at a suitable distance. If the weather is wet we will use the school hall and restrict the number of students in the room at any time to maintain social distancing. This year I am asking that parents do not come into school to reduce the risk of infection. I hope to create something of a results day atmosphere as the students have worked hard for these grades over 5 years. We have submitted grades which we believe are fair and reflect that hard work.

This year there isn't an option for re-marks, teachers have submitted the grades after careful consideration of all aspects of each students work. We can appeal if we believe there has been a clerical error and there will also be an option to re-sit GCSEs in all subjects in November. Staff will be available to offer advice on this and on post-16 applications. All the Colleges have information on their websites about enrolment in September.
