Dear Parents/Carers

We have been notified that Intra Health will be administering the COVID vaccines for students aged 12 to 15 in school on Monday 11 and Tuesday 12 October 2021.

With this letter you will find a guide with all the information you need to help you decide if you want your child to have the vaccine. This is entirely your decision and we have been assured by Intra Health that they will not be administering any vaccines to young people without parental consent.

Your child will be given a paper consent for on Monday 4 October and this needs to be returned to school by Wednesday 6 October. The form should be returned to indicate that decision either way. This is a tight deadline so if you do want your child to receive the vaccine please return the form the next day.

Those under 12, which will be most of Year 7, will not be offered the vaccine. Those in Year 11 who are already 16 must book an appointment with their GP or at the local vaccine centres. Intra Health will not administer vaccines to any Year 11 student who is already 16 on 4 October 2021.

The information in the attached leaflet and that issued with the consent form should inform your decision on this like all childhood vaccines. As a school we are facilitating the process and will make sure it runs as smoothly as possible.
