## JOB DESCRIPTION

### Apprentice Administration Assistant L3 (70% of SCP 2)

**Job Title:** Apprentice Administration Assistant

**Reporting To:** SEN Administration Officer

**Overall Purpose of the Job:** To provide routine administration and clerical support in the SEN office

#### Principal Accountabilities:

- To provide routine administrative and clerical support, using a range of systems, in the SEN office.
- To work with the SEN Administration Officer and support the SEN team.
- To act as primary First Aider on dedicated rota forming part of the First Aid cover team.
- To support reception duties including offering an efficient response to all visitors to the school and dealing with internal and external telephone queries in a courteous manner.
- Undertake general administration tasks and filing as and when needed.
- Perform other such duties as reasonably correspond to the general character of the post and are commensurate with its level of responsibility.

The post holder may also be asked to provide support in other areas of the school when necessary and as appropriate to their role.

#### General Information:

- The above principal accountabilities are not exhaustive and may vary without changing the character of the job or level of responsibility.
- The Health and Safety at Work etc. Act, 1974 and other associated legislation places responsibilities for Health and Safety on all employees. Therefore it is the postholder's responsibility to take reasonable care for Health and Safety and Welfare of him/herself and other employees in accordance with legislation.
