

## Mobile phones



- Roaming no longer include in Europe (see your mobile provider) students will only be able to use phone when wi-fi available.
- No mobile phones to be brought to evening meal.
- Students can have their phone in Disneyland and need parental consent to use WHATSAPP
- We ask students not to contact parents if they have any question/problem, they should see staff member and then we will contact you if there is a problem.

#### Passports GHIC



- Final reminder the students need their own passport.
- Passports must be in hand luggage.
- All passports and GHIC will be collected in before departing from Market Weighton
- They will be retained and kept in the hotel safe and distributed on the return journey back to Britain.









From 1 August 2022, all COVID-19 travel restrictions for travellers to France have been lifted. The rules that previously applied to travellers coming to France no longer apply:

- you are no longer required to present proof of vaccination
- you are no longer required to fill out any forms prior to your arrival in France, such as a justification for travel or a sworn statement
- you are no longer required to show proof of a negative PCR or antigen test upon arrival in France











- 49 seater executive coach (equipped with air conditioning, reclining seats, seat belts, DVD and toilet, plus 2 drivers and feeder.the UK will be fitted with seatbelts.
- Staff will ensure that they are worn at all times.
- Please stress to your son/daughter the importance of this safety issue.
- Sensible behaviour is required at all times especially on exiting the coach.
- No nuts, chewing gum or fizzy drink.







# Food for the journey

- Packed lunches/snack required.
- No nuts:

This means that the following items should not be brought on the coach.

Packs of nuts Peanut butter sandwiches Nutella/ Chocolate Spread sandwiches Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts ie tracker bars Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts Sesame seed rolls (children allergic to nuts may also have a severe reaction to sesame) Cakes made with nuts

•It will be a very long night/day so extra food required.

•Potentially budget for 1 stop at Dover in morning - £10


