COVID-19 - ALL

• you are no longer required to fill out any forms prior to your arrival in France, such as a justification for travel or a sworn statement

For NON vaccinated travelers only

 you are STILL required to show proof of a negative PCR or antigen test upon arrival in France no older that 72 hours
